Subject	Pupil Activity	Parent/Carer Role	Time Allocation
English	<p>Read a home reader, brought home daily.</p> <p>Learn a set of spellings each week (given Thursday, tested the next Tuesday) – in addition to spellings of the week.</p> <p>Carry out a specific piece of English comprehension practice set on Tuesday, due in on Friday.</p>	<p>Listen to your child read at least two times a week.</p> <p>Help your child learn their spellings, ensuring that they know what the words mean.</p> <p>Support your child where necessary.</p>	<p>20 minutes per night.</p> <p>15 minutes per week.</p> <p>30 minutes per week.</p>
Maths	<p>To practise maths skills each day specified by the class teacher (e.g. tables or number bonds). There will be a tables test on Monday morning.</p> <p>Carry out a specific piece of maths work - set on Monday, due in on Thursday.</p>	<p>Support and participate in this activity.</p> <p>Support your child where necessary.</p>	<p>5 minutes per day.</p> <p>30 minutes per week.</p>
Topic Work	<p>To carry out a set activity/piece of work related to another area of the curriculum.</p>	<p>This may require your child to research information from both the library and other sources.</p>	<p>1 hour per week.</p>
